Export of a computer to Poland

Memorandum by the United Kingdom Delegation

The United Kingdom authorities have been asked to approve the export to Poland of the following:-

2. This computer is required by Varimex for the Nuclear Research Institute, Swierk near Warsaw, The head of this Institute, Professor Noracki, who is well known to Professor Cockroft of the United Kingdom Atomic Energy Authority, wants to use the instrument as a research and training simulator.

3. Her Majesty's Government wish to authorise the sale of this computer to the Institute under the special Polish exceptions procedure and the usual assurance against re-export will be obtained. They hope that views of Member Governments will be available by December 3.
