Subj: CIA map "USSR: Railroads, 1950"; comments on (S)

1. Reference (a) solicited comments relative to the accuracy and overall usefulness of the subject map.
2. A thorough check of FICPAC intelligence files confirms the accuracy of the subject map and indicates that the following confirmed items should be included in the next revision:
 - a. Single track railroad from USHUMUM 5245N/12635E north to DAMBUKI 5418N/12737E via ZEYA 5345N/12716E.
 - b. Single track railroad from ARKHARA 4925N/13007E southwest to INNOKENTYEVKA 4918N/12942E.
 - c. The electrification of the Trans Siberian railroad between CHEREMHOVO 5247N/10808E and IRKUTSK 5216N/10420E has been completed.
3. Unconfirmed information indicates the existence of the following:
 - a. Single track railroad linking KHABAROVSK 4830N/13506E with the KAMCHATKA Peninsula now under construction.
 - b. Single track railroad connecting UST KAMCHATEK 5615N/16230E and PETROPAVLOVSK 5301N/15839E now under construction.
4. The subject map definitely supplements FICPAC intelligence files. This command requests that similar rail studies of CHINA and S. E. ASIA be forwarded if and when available.
