Without any prior advice or reply to reference (c) the undersigned on 9 December 1959 received notification by postal card [REDACTED] from the Railway Express Agency advising that a box was on hand at the Railway Express Agency from the [REDACTED] not deliverable because of insufficient address. [REDACTED] was called immediately and advised of the above facts. In reply to a question, [REDACTED] advised that the special G Area courier could claim and deliver the box to the office of the undersigned. This was done on 10 December 1959. 25X1A5a1 25X1A9a

2. The box, protected under a protective signature service, contained (a) a letter and one carbon of transmittal from [REDACTED] with attached two copies of short-form receipts for classified material, (b) a receipt and one carbon for classified material (c) a certified list of destruction, and (d) the classified reports listed in item b. 25X1A5a1

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3. The classified material was examined, and in addition to the correspondence, was found to contain not only classified items 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 12 of Reference (a), but also all of the remaining classified reports which the [REDACTED] did not choose to retain under the conditions outlined in Reference (d). 25X1A5a1

25X1A5a1 4. A careful check-out was made of the reports in the box against the list of Reference (a) as well as the list enclosed in the box (2b above). [One minor discrepancy was noted. The box contained copy No. 9 rather than No. 8 as listed in Reference (a)]. The [REDACTED] chose to retain only the unclassified reports listed in Reference (a) (items 6, 13, 14, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22.) The most recent correspondence makes no mention of having complied with the three conditions outlined in Reference (d). The Security Staff of the Office of Logistics may choose to call this to the attention of the [REDACTED]
