Inspector General's Survey of the Medical

- 1. The Inspector General's Survey makes eleven (11) specific recommendations, which have been carefully reviewed and a full report thereon is attached hereto.
- 2. In accordance with Recommendation #1, the Chief, Medical Staff, has been formally commended for his role in the development of the Agency's Medical Program, and a copy placed in his official file.
- 3. I concur with the Chief, Medical Staff, in his substantial agreement with all of the other recommendations except #2 and #6. Regarding these two areas of disagreement, I will confer with the Inspector General and the Chief, Medical Staff in order to arrive at a mutually acceptable statement and resolution of these differences.
