Comments on the Soviet Economy:

Page 2, last line, add after "is devoted to," the words  
"investment, largely" (to heavy industry)

Page 3, line 4 delete "less than 25 percent"  
substitute "less than 20 percent"

Page 3, lines 16-17 delete, "yet the USSR spends twenty times  
as much on railroads as we do."  
Substitute "yet the USSR spends substantially  
more on railroads than we do.

Page 3, line 22 delete "by deflating Soviet statistics."  
substitute "by converting Soviet statistics  
to U.S. equivalents."

Page 3, lines 27-29 Suggest deletion for policy reasons.

Page 4, line 3 delete "not higher than 40 percent"  
substitute "much closer to 40 percent"
