- 4. The DCI called on H. R. 3880 and was advised that McCabe did not want to sit in on any meetings and Merriam preferred to hold off until early next week meeting with CIA. The Director indicated he had wanted White House guidance prior to seeing Senator Mundt. The Director stated he would call Merriam. Subsequently he did and Merriam confirmed he did not see any real point in meeting with CIA until next week. The Director queried him as to whether there was any objection to raising the Freedom Commission bills before the OCB and Merriam indicated there was no reason why it should not be done.
