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President Truman's Letter,

January 22, 1946

January 22, 1946

To the Secretary of State,  
The Secretary of War, and  
The Secretary of the Navy.

1. It is my desire, and I hereby direct, that all Federal foreign intelligence activities be planned, developed and coordinated so as to assure the most effective accomplishment of the intelligence mission related to the national security. I hereby designate you, together with another person to be named by me as my personal representative, as the National Intelligence Authority to accomplish this purpose.

2. Within the limits of available appropriations, you shall each from time to time assign persons and facilities from your respective Departments, which persons shall collectively form a Central Intelligence Group and shall, under the direction of a Director of Central Intelligence, assist the National Intelligence Authority. The Director of Central Intelligence shall be designated by me, shall be responsible to the National Intelligence Authority, and shall sit as a non-voting member thereof.

3. Subject to the existing law, and to the direction and control of the National Intelligence Authority, the Director of Central Intelligence shall:

a. Accomplish the correlation and evaluation of intelligence relating to the national security, and the appropriate dissemination within the Government of the resulting strategic and national policy intelligence. In so doing, full use shall be made of the staff and facilities of the intelligence agencies of your Departments.

b. Plan for the coordination of such of the activities of the intelligence agencies of your Departments as relate to the national security and recommend to the National Intelligence Authority the establishment of such over-all policies and objectives as will assure the most effective accomplishment of the national intelligence mission.

c. Perform, for the benefit of said intelligence agencies, such services of common concern as the National Intelligence Authority determines can be more efficiently accomplished centrally.

d. Perform such other functions and duties related to intelligence affecting the national security as the President and the National Intelligence Authority may from time to time direct.

4. No police, law enforcement or internal security functions shall be exercised under this directive.

5. Such intelligence received by the intelligence agencies of your Departments as may be designated by the National Intelligence Authority shall be freely available to the Director of

Central Intelligence for correlation, evaluation or dissemination. To the extent approved by the National Intelligence Authority, the operations of said intelligence agencies shall be open to inspection by the Director of Central Intelligence in connection with planning functions.

6. The existing intelligence agencies of your Departments shall continue to collect, evaluate, correlate and disseminate departmental intelligence.

7. The Director of Central Intelligence shall be advised by an Intelligence Advisory Board consisting of the heads (or their representatives) of the principal military and civilian intelligence agencies of the Government having functions related to national security, as determined by the National Intelligence Authority.

8. Within the scope of existing law and Presidential directives, other departments and agencies of the executive branch of the Federal Government shall furnish such intelligence information relating to the national security as is in their possession, and as the Director of Central Intelligence may from time to time request pursuant to regulations of the National Intelligence Authority.

9. Nothing herein shall be construed to authorize the making of investigations inside the continental limits of the United States and its possessions, except as provided by law and Presidential directives.

10. In the conduct of their activities the National Intelligence Authority and the Director of Central Intelligence shall

be responsible for fully protecting intelligence sources and  
methods.

**DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE**  
 Pursuant to existing law and the direction and control of N.I.A., the Director of Central Intelligence performs the following functions as specified in the President's directive of 22 January 1946 and as amended by the N.I.A.  
 1. Sits as a non-voting member of the National Intelligence Authority.  
 2. Directs all activities of the Central Intelligence Group.  
 3. Correlates, evaluates and disseminates strategic and national policy intelligence within the government.  
 4. Plans for coordination of intelligence activities related to national security and recommends to N.I.A. overall policies and objectives to accomplish national intelligence mission.  
 5. Performs services of common concern as directed by N.I.A.  
 6. Performs other functions and duties related to national security intelligence as directed by the President and the N.I.A.  
**DEPUTY DIRECTOR**  
 Assists the Director in the discharge of his functions and acts for him in his absence.

**SECRETARIAT**  
 Performs personal secretarial services for the Director of Central Intelligence and maintains for him a temporary office of record.

**INTERDEPARTMENTAL COORDINATION AND PLANNING STAFF**  
 1. The Interdepartmental Coordinating and Planning Staff acts for the Director of Central Intelligence in the coordination of all intelligence activities related to the national security, and in the preparation of recommendations regarding the establishment of overall policies and plans to assure the most effective accomplishment of the national intelligence mission.  
 2. In discharging these responsibilities this staff will maintain continuous supervision of the planning and coordination of the intelligence activities of the Central Intelligence Group. It will focus its activities on the coordination of the intelligence activities of the State, War, Navy and other governmental departments and individuals concerned, to assure that:  
 a. The facilities of each activity are adequate to discharge its responsibilities;  
 b. All appropriate fields of intelligence endeavor are adequately covered;  
 c. The facilities of the Central Intelligence Group are operating to provide the best possible service to the State, War, Navy and other governmental departments and individuals concerned;  
 d. Raw information from all sources and activities is received by the Central Intelligence Group and, where appropriate, promptly distributed to the State, War, Navy and other governmental departments and individuals concerned;  
 e. The intelligence requirements of the State, War, Navy and other governmental departments and individuals concerned are adequately met;  
 f. Methods, procedures and controls are adequate within the Central Intelligence Group and the State, War, Navy and other governmental departments for the expeditious collection and integrated research and evaluation of information, and for the prompt dissemination of strategic and national policy intelligence.

**EXECUTIVE OFFICE**  
 Functions as a staff for the Director of Central Intelligence in performing the normal duties of an executive office in planning, controlling, administering and securing the activities of the Central Intelligence Group.

**SECRETARY-NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE AUTHORITY**  
 Furnishes secretariat for the National Intelligence Authority and the Intelligence Community. Coordinates with the executive staff on appropriate matters.

**OFFICE OF SPECIAL OPERATIONS**  
 Asst. Director for Special Operations  
 1. The agency responsible for the performance of certain special functions assigned to the Director of Central Intelligence, by the President.

**OFFICE OF COLLECTION**  
 Asst. Director for Collection  
 1. Acts for the Director of Central Intelligence in the collection of foreign intelligence information required for the production of strategic and national policy intelligence as it affects the national security of the United States.  
 2. In close coordination with the collection agencies of other governmental departments, determines the means and methods most appropriate for obtaining foreign intelligence information to enable the Research and Development Office, Central Intelligence Group to produce strategic and national policy intelligence.

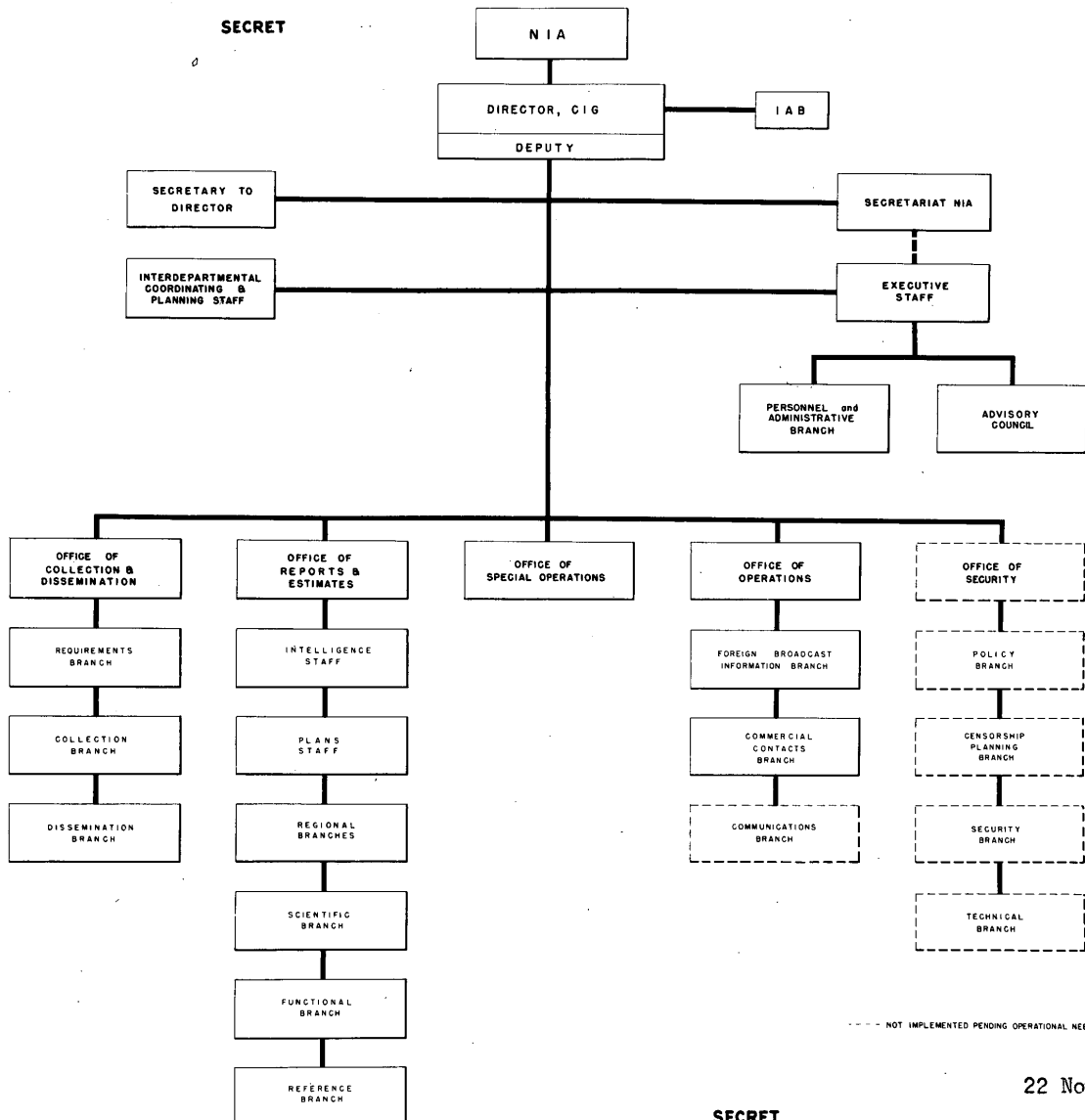
**OFFICE OF RESEARCH AND EVALUATION**  
 Asst. Director for Research and Evaluation  
 1. The agency of the Director of Central Intelligence which establishes requirements for and produces strategic and national policy intelligence affecting the national security for use as required by the various departments of the government.  
 2. In close coordination with appropriate intelligence divisions of participating governmental agencies, conducts the necessary review, research, evaluation and integration of foreign information and intelligence, and evaluates the significance of trends and developments as they affect the national security.

**OFFICE OF DISSEMINATION**  
 Asst. Director for Dissemination  
 The agency of the Director of Central Intelligence responsible for the dissemination of evaluated strategic and national policy intelligence produced by the Office of Research and Evaluation, Central Intelligence Group.

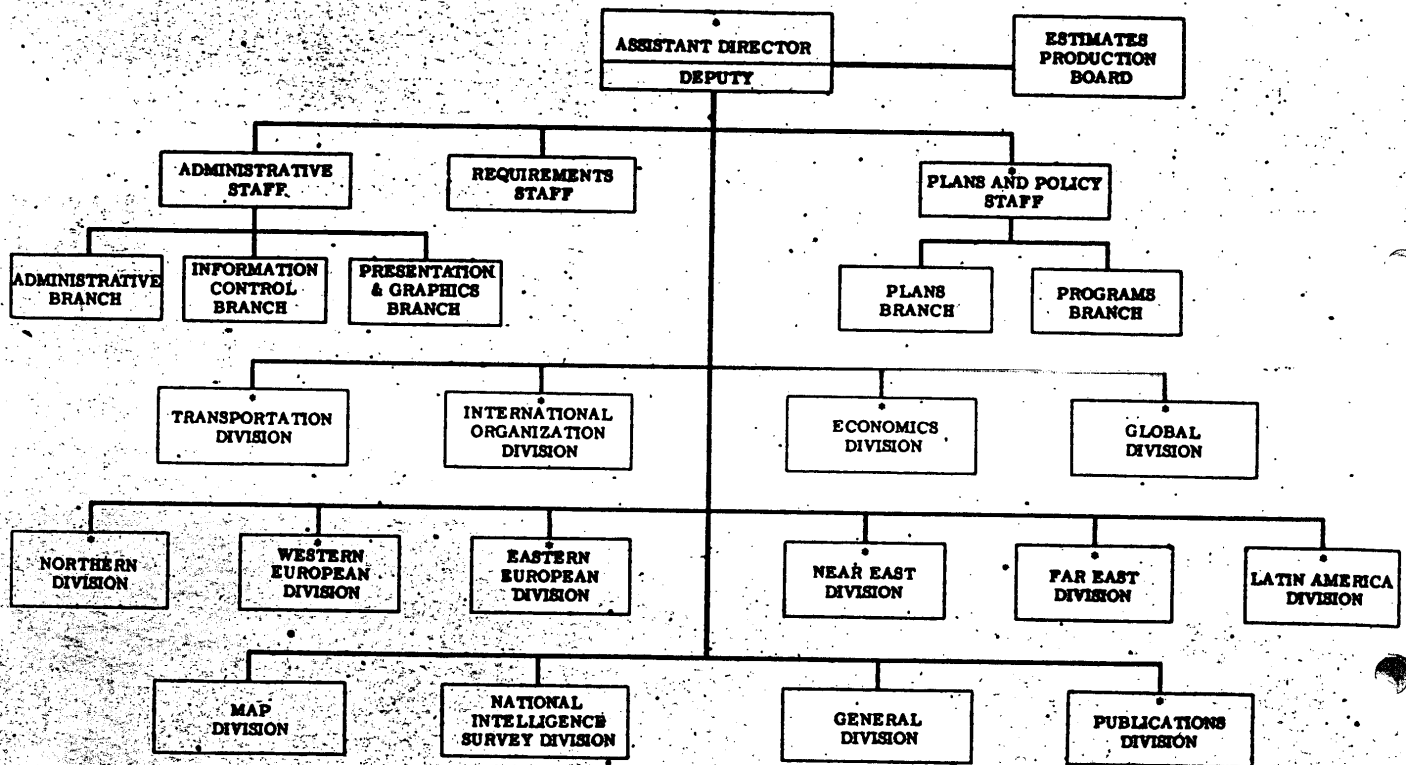

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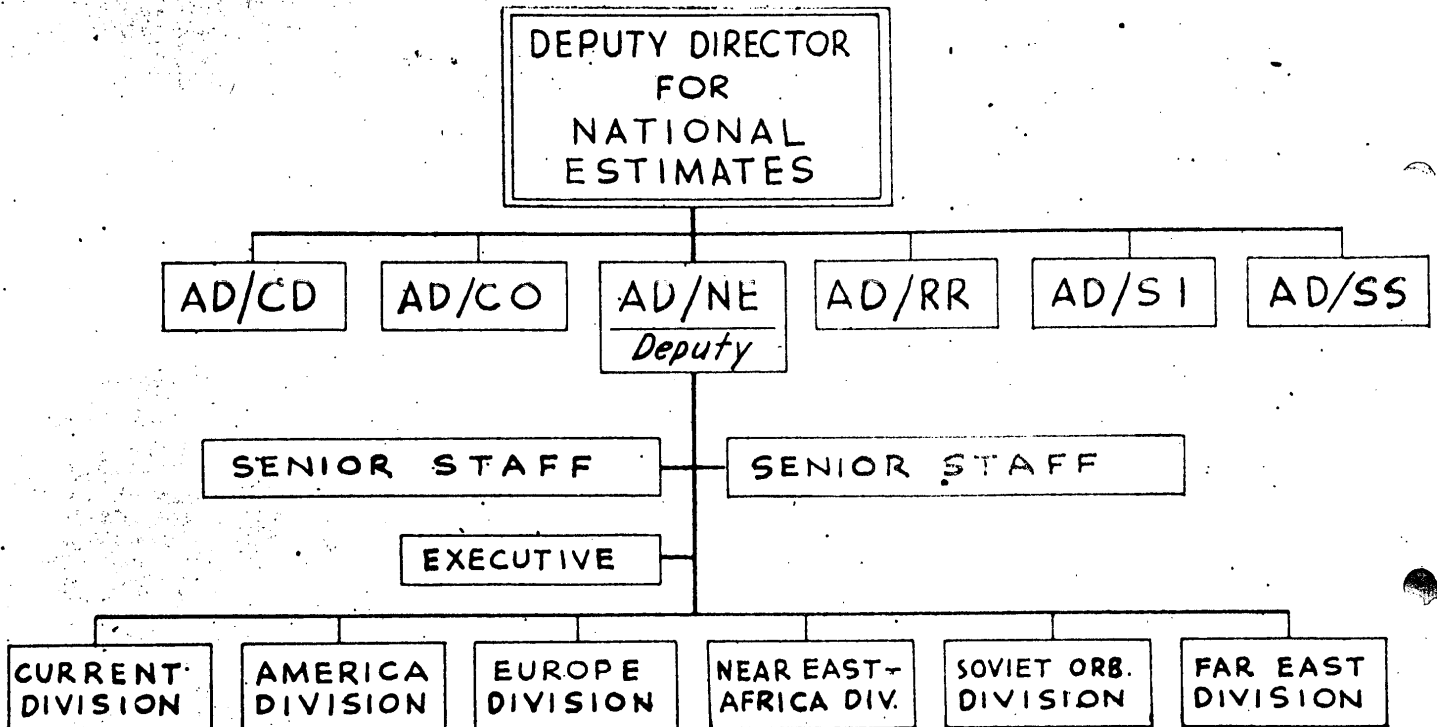
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PROPOSED REORGANIZATION OF CIA'S INTELLIGENCE OFFICES

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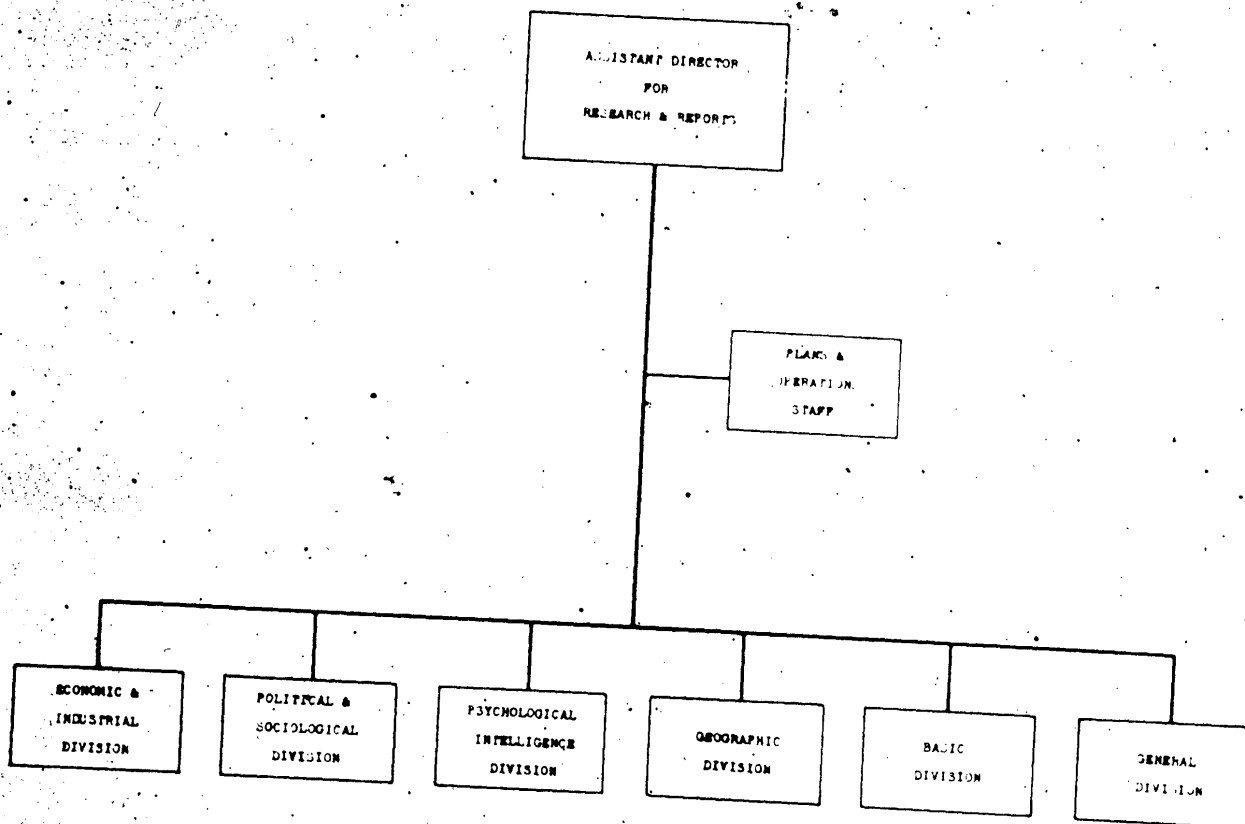
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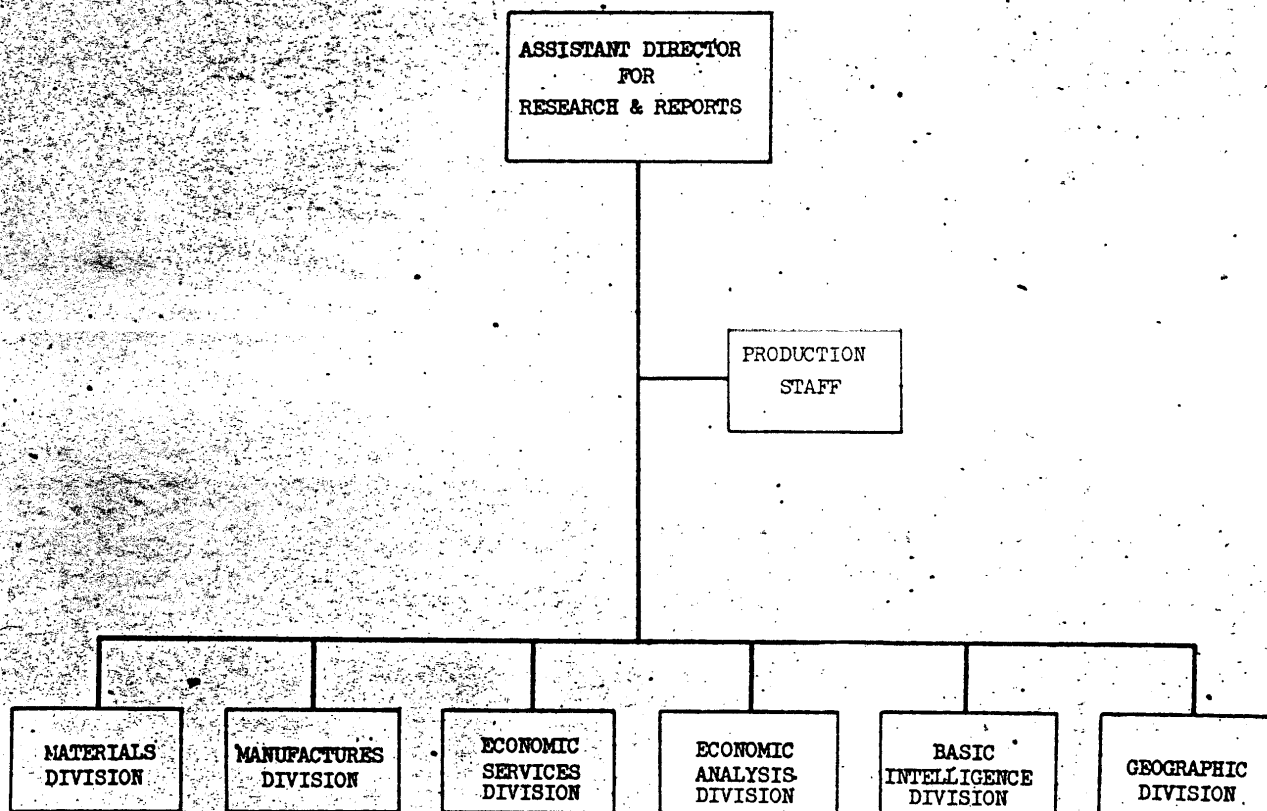
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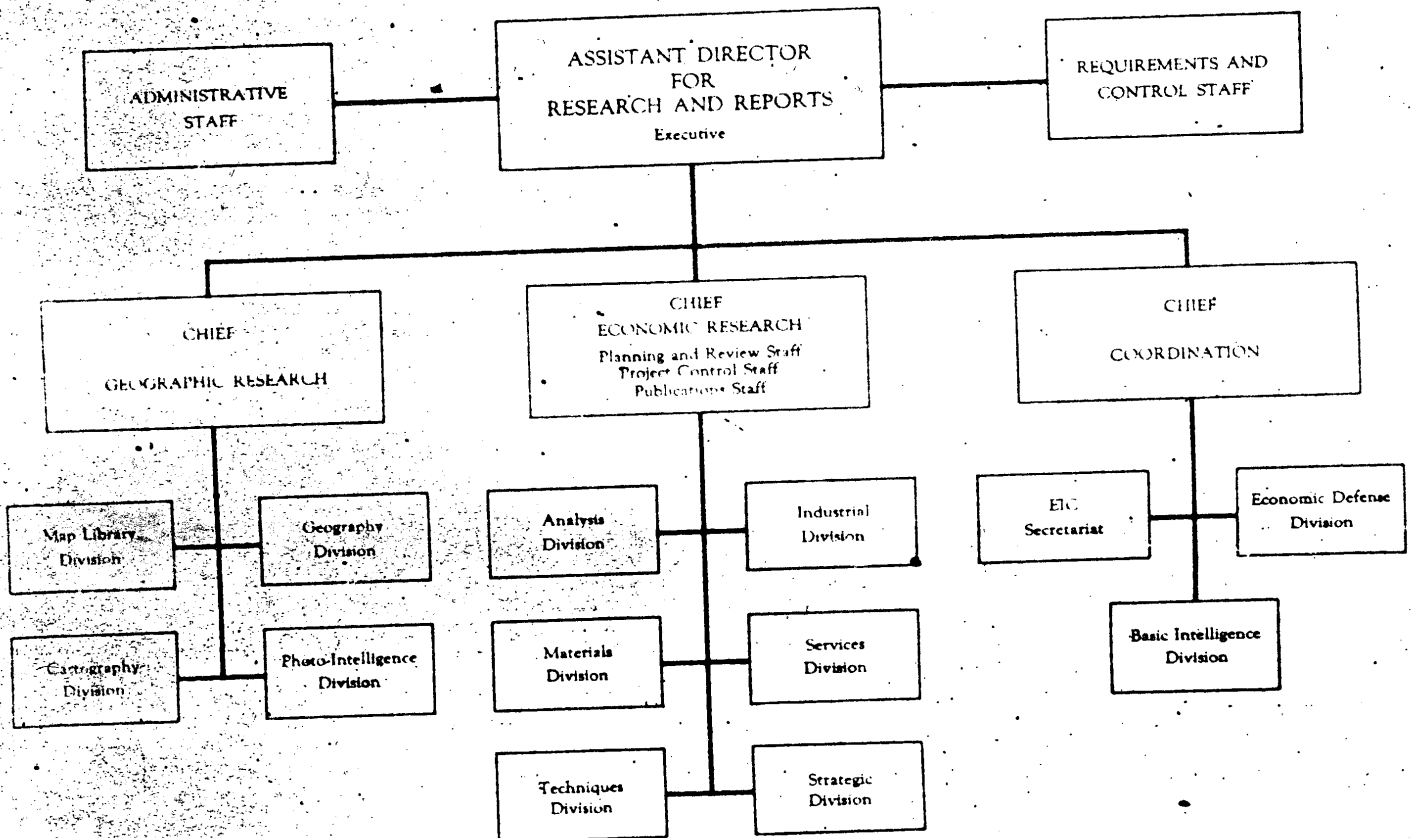
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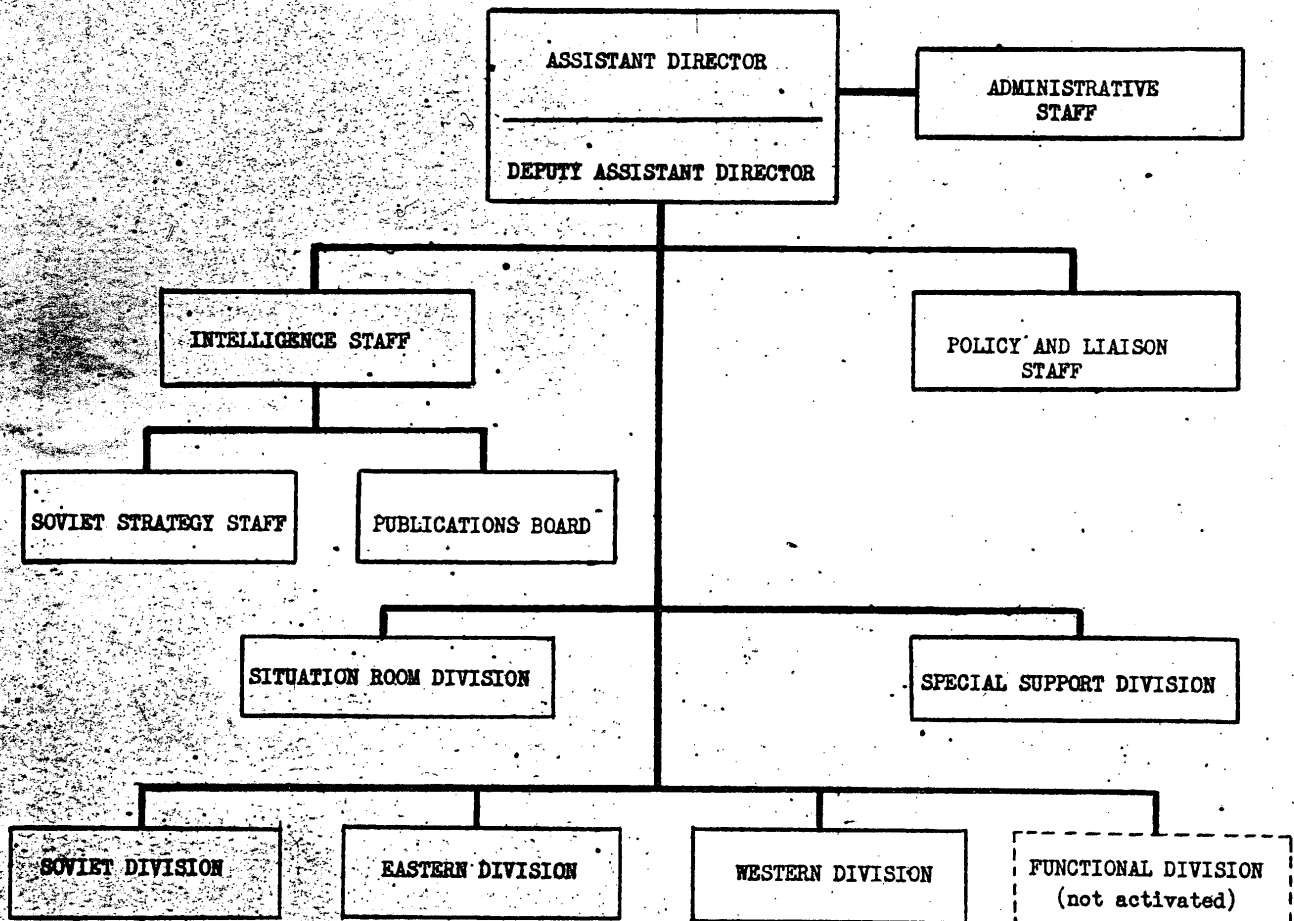


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ORGANIZATION CHART, OFFICE OF CURRENT INTELLIGENCE



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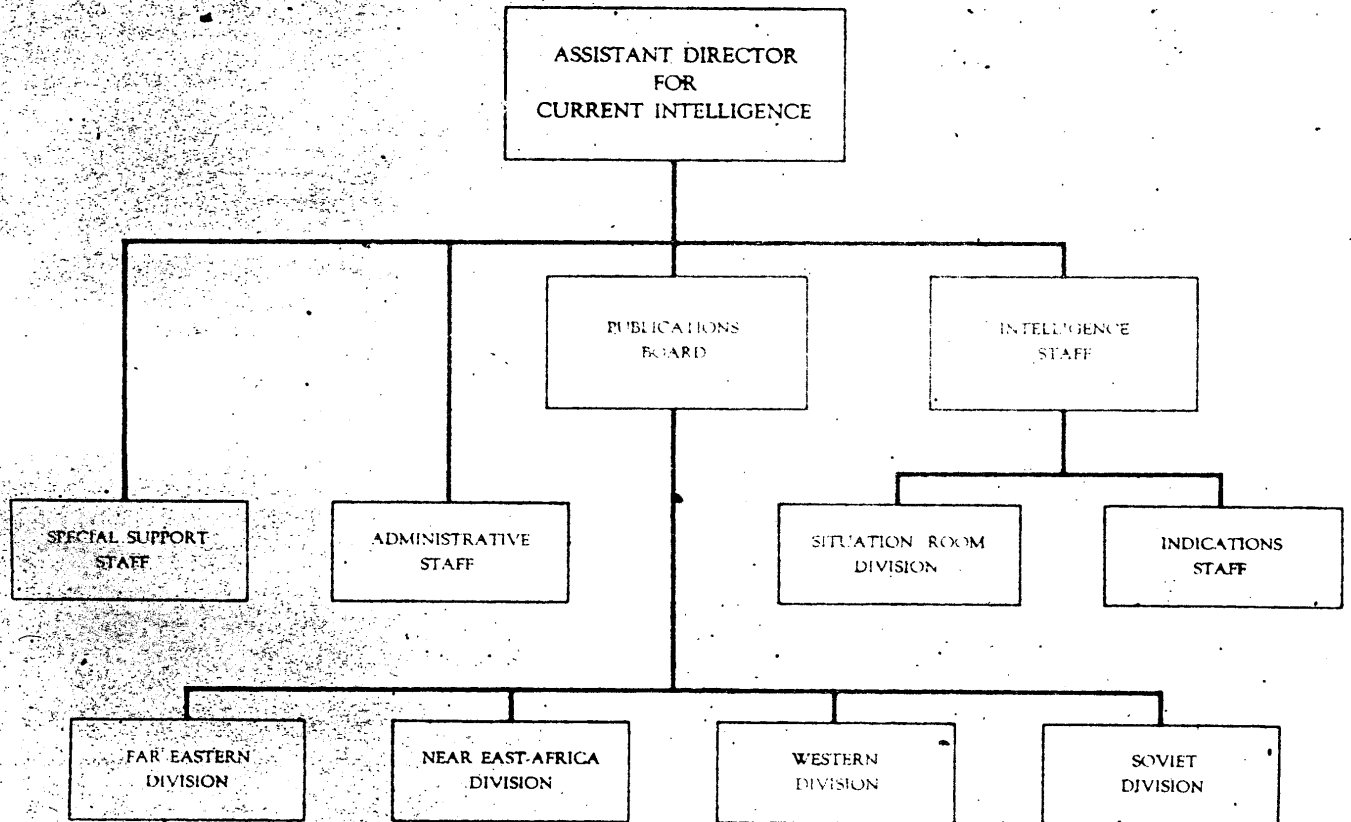
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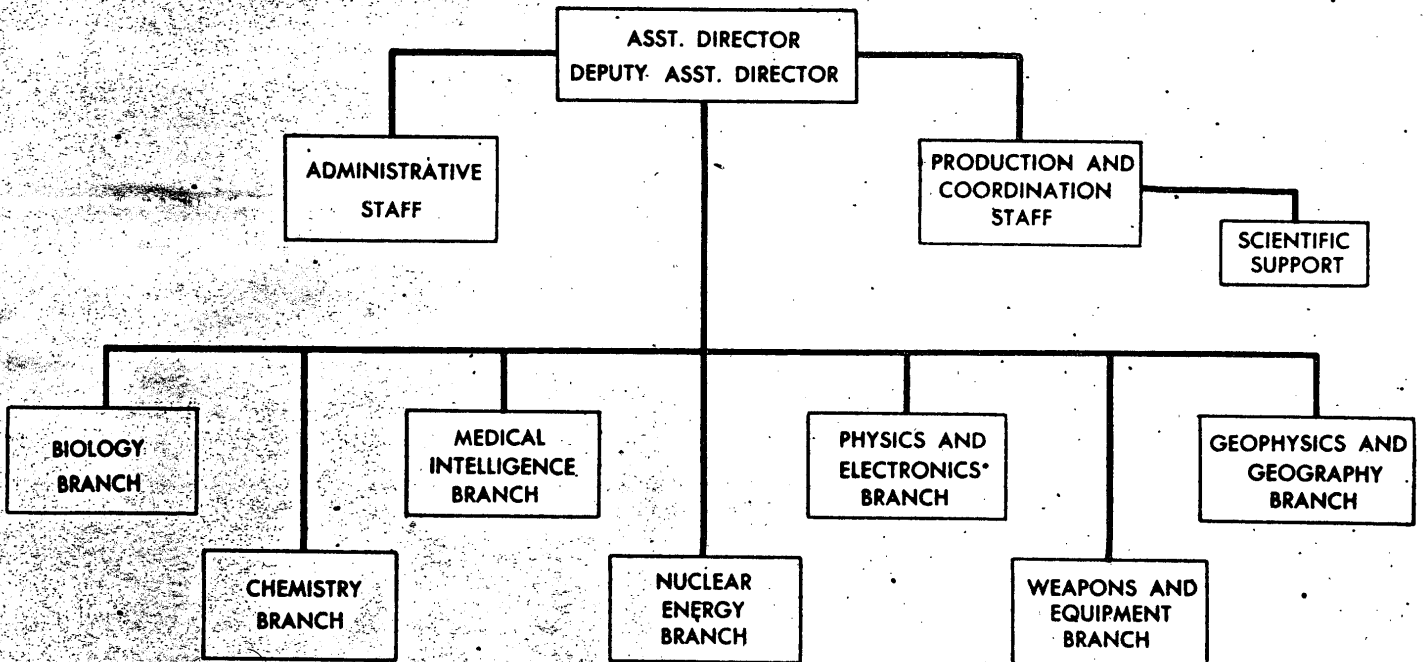

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### ORGANIZATION OF OSI NOVEMBER 1, 1950

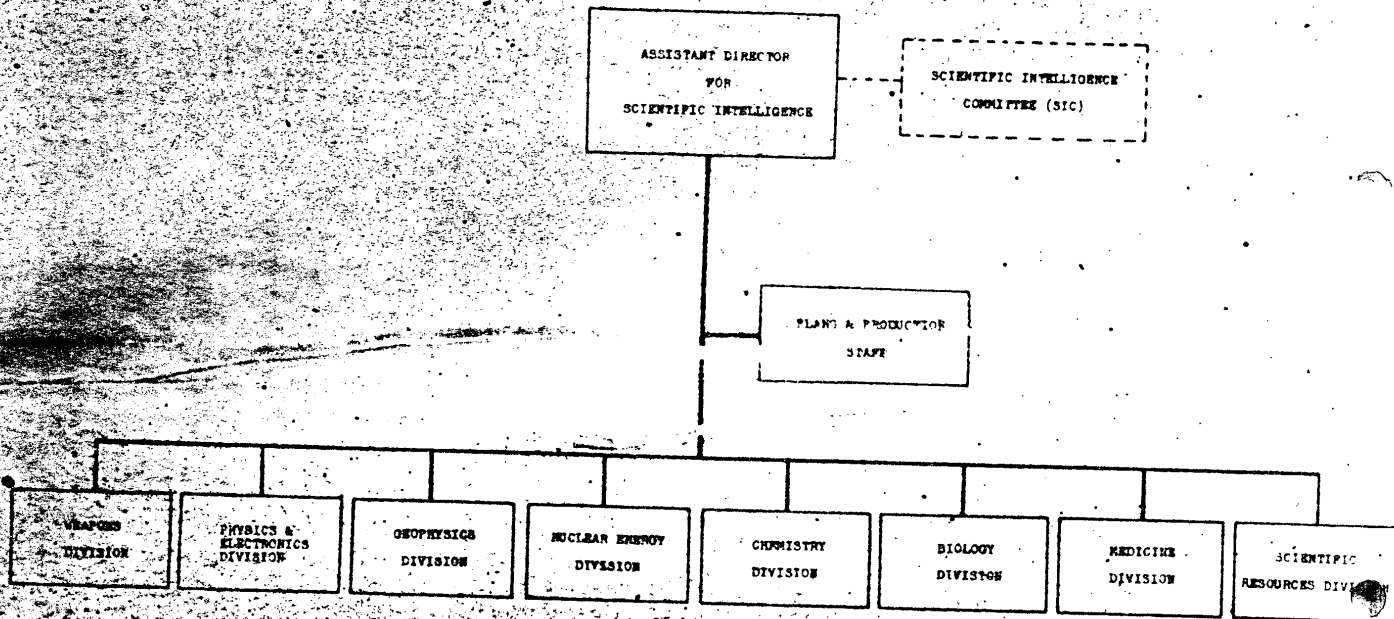
