MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE

Subject: Publications Review Subcommittee

1. Pursuant to a directive of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the Joint Intelligence Committee has established a Publications Review Subcommittee. The history and functions of that subcommittee are described in paragraphs 2 through 10 of the Enclosure to J.I.C. 86/9, a copy of which is attached.

2. It is the opinion of the Joint Intelligence Committee that the functions which it exercises through the Publications Review Subcommittee come within the cognizance of the National Intelligence Authority and should be assumed by the Authority at the earliest practicable date. The Joint Intelligence Committee therefore requests an expression of your opinion and intentions with reference to this matter and, if you concur in the opinion of the J.I.C., a statement as to the date on which you would expect the National Intelligence Authority to undertake such functions.
