PROGRAM FOR ASSURING THE DIRECTION, COORDINATION AND SUPERVISION OF THE OPERATIONS WHICH PRODUCE INTELLIGENCE RELATED TO THE NATIONAL SECURITY

PART II-B:

INTER-AGENCY COMMITTEE FOR THE COORDINATION OF THE COLLECTION OF MILITARY INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION

Reference: a. C.I.G. Directive No.

Memorandum by the Director of Central Intelligence
with the unanimous concurrence of the
Intelligence Advisory Board

- 1. Pursuant to paragraph 5 of reference Directive, a permanent inter-agency Committee for the Coordination of the Collection of Military Intelligence Information, to assist the Collection Coordination Board, is hereby established.
 - 2. The organization and functions of this Committee are as follows:
 - a. Membership. The Committee shall consist of the following:
 - (1) A collection representative of C.I.G.;
 - (2) One military specialist representative each of: the Office of Collection and Dissemination, Department of State; the Collection Group, Intelligence Division, WDGS; the Collection and Dissemination Group, Foreign Branch, ONI; the Air Information Division, Office of AC/AS-2;
 - (3) Such additional or temporary members as the Director of Central Intelligence may determine to be required;
 - (4) Secretariat furnished by C.I.G.

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- b. Functions. The functions of the Committee will include:
- (1) The execution of directives of the Collection Coordination Board and assistance to that Board in the detailed performance of its functions related to the collection of military intelligence information;
- (2) Recommendations to the Collection Coordination Board of special collecting missions to meet specified military intelligence needs;
- (3) Recommendations to the Collection Coordination Board of priorities and dead-lines indicated by detailed requirements in the field of military intelligence;
- (4) Initiation of action required of the Collection Coordination Board with relation to specific working needs of the agencies represented;
- (5) Continuing determination of the adequacy of means and coverage for the collection of military intelligence information and recommendations to the Collection Coordination Board of measures to correct inadequacies.
- (6) The Committee will have no planning functions except those pertaining specifically to its own operations.
- c. Procedure. The Committee shall:
- (1) Elect its own chairman and establish its own internal procedure;
- (2) Implement its agreed decisions in matters within its scope;
- (3) Refer to the Collection Coordination Board any operating problem upon which prompt agreement cannot be reached;
- (h) Obtain from the member agencies such administrative and technical assistance as may be required, in addition to the Committee's own members, for the authorized work of the Committee.

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- <u>d. Subcommittees.</u> The Committee is authorized to establish such subcommittees as may be required, arranging for personnel directly with the member agencies through the representatives of such agencies on the Committee.
- e. <u>Liaison</u>. The Committee will establish and maintain, through its chairman, close and constant liaison with any and all similar specialist committees which may be established by parallel or subsequent action.
