Memorandum by the Director of Central Intelligence with unanimous concurrence by the Intelligence Advisory Board

- 1. In view of the approaching completion of the United States Strategic Bombing Survey (USSBS), it is necessary to provide for the screening and disposition of the organization's files. At the suggestion of the Chairman, USSBS, the Central Intelligence Group is initiating action herewith.

Each member of the Intelligence advisory Board will designate the account of the materials will designate the presentatives who will be authorized to consult with the Intelligence Branch, Central Planning Staff, and to indicate the desires of the agency concerned.
- 4. At the conclusion of the survey, the Central Planning Staff will submit its findings, conclusions and recommendations to the Director of Central Intelligence, who will then submit appropriate recommendations to the National Intelligence Authority, after concurrence or comment by the Intelligence Advisory Board.
