2. Delivered to the staffs of the Bouse Armed Services Committee, the House and Senate Appropriations Committees and the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy Mr. McCones' letters suggesting that he get together with these groups at their earliest convenience.

In my chat with Bob Smart, House Armed Services Consulties staff, he informed me that Chairman Vincon has decided to appoint himself chairman of the CiA Subcommittee. Smart said that while the Chairman as well as the ranking Minority Leader were as officio members of all subcommittees, Mr. Vincon made it a policy set to sit in on Subcommittee hearings. He felt that his presence might give the Subcommittee chairman the feeling that Vincon was looking over his shoulder. Smart said it was difficult for him to brief Chairman Vincon on all that transpired at GIA hearings and that for these reasons Mr. Vincon has decided to take the post himself. Smart said he assumed we would be pleased with this information and I indicated that folged we were.

3. Delivered to Jim McKeans, in the office of Senator John O. Pastore (D., R.I.), Mr. Warner's letter replying to one from the Senator concerning the case of McSienna said the letter was precisely what they needed and he appreciated our promptness in handling the matter.
