3. [REDACTED] - GLC) Called Diane Kincaid, in the office of Senator Stuart Symington, in connection with correspondence from Mr. [REDACTED] which had been forwarded to us by the Senator's office. I advised Miss Kincaid that [REDACTED] had been in touch with our [REDACTED] field office and that as a result of that contact our people met with [REDACTED] who had been the subject of [REDACTED] letters. I asked Miss Kincaid if she would like a note on this and she said it would not be necessary, that she would give the Senator a note herself. She did mention in passing that [REDACTED] had called and spoken with the Senator several days ago. However, she is not aware of the substance of the conversation.

4. [REDACTED] - GLC) I called John Leahy, Congressional Relations Office of State Department, and advised him of my conversation with Mrs. Birtch, secretary to Mr. Fred Dutton in State Department, concerning State's letter to Senator Dirksen regarding the [REDACTED]. Leahy said he was going to drop by Dirksen's office and talk with Mr. Gomien to determine if the Senator's office had all the information it desired on this subject. Mr. Leahy will inform Mrs. Birtch of our conversation. I advised Leahy that I understood that the Senator had written a second letter to the Department forwarding a copy of a form letter from [REDACTED] and that State was preparing a similar response to this letter.
