25X1 1. [ ] Talked further with [ ]  
25X1 [ ] and after consulting the Director's calendar, a firm date was set for the Director's appearance before House Foreign Affairs Committee. The date is Tuesday, 27 February 1962 at 10:30 a.m.

25X1 2. [ ] The Director appeared before the combined CIA Subcommittees of Senate Armed Services and Senate Appropriations. All present members of the Subcommittees were present including Senators Russell, Hayden, Byrd, Chavez, Robertson, Saltonstall, Young, and Stennis. A transcript was taken. See Memorandum for the record for further details.

25X1 3. [ ] [ ] Communications, called in connection with our request for their comments on a draft bill submitted to us by the Bureau of the Budget containing amendments to the Communications Act of 1934 with respect to providing for reciprocity with foreign countries in the field of radio transmission.  
25X1 [ ] said Mr. Helms had been very much interested in similar legislation in 1958 and he proposes to discuss the matter with him.

25X1 4. [ ] [ ] Desk, called to say a contact in State Department had indicated to him that in his report on his recent trip to the Soviet Union and elsewhere Senator Allen J. Ellender made some critical comments about the Agency. Copies of the Senator's report will be sent to Laux and to the other interested Agency components.
