The students are from both sexes and many nationalities.

Subjects include processes of infiltration and sabotage, methods of forming and leading dissident groups wit in the Western countries, English, etc.

It was believed (1950) that graduates of the school in the castle have been or will be given DP status, thus gaining entrance to Western countries.

Course of instruction lasts two years.
