1. Taiked with Mir. Mahan following up on his expressed view yesterday through Bob Michaels that he would like to raise the \$75 million item with the Subcommittee at yesterday's meeting. Mr. Mahan indicated he had hoped very much to put this up for discussion and in fact had talked to the Chairman about it earlier. After some discussion of ways to proceed including specifically a proposal that we address a letter to him asking for clarification of what his Defense Subcommittee intended when reporting out the DOD bill, Mr. Mahan suggested that I work with Mr. Michaels on this indicating clearly that he would rely as Michaels for advice. Subsequently, I discussed this with Michaels and he plans to drop by the Agency temperow morning to look over a proposed letter to Mr. Mahan from the Agency.

4. William Saltonstall advised that Senator Saltonstall would like to get a general briefing on the Soviet fishing trawlers. I indicated we, of course, would be happy to do this and it was agreed that I would contact the Senator's office early Tuesday to determine an appropriate time for the briefing.

3. telephaned to advise STAT that in view of the time factors Senator Thurshoud has agreed that the Senate Preparedness Investigating Subcommittee should not take any further witnesses, thus negating his written request to Stennis for the recall of Mr. McCone. I thanked for this information. STAT
