25X1 [redacted] Talked with General Roderick and Dave McGiffert indicating our concern that the security procedures followed by most of the contract reporting firms with particular reference [redacted] in connection with sensitive briefings by the Executive Branch of congressional committees is not satisfactory. I indicated that the Agency planned to institute some new arrangements with the cooperation of the specific committees but thought that possibly DOD and the Agency should be in step on this. Roderick will look into this matter with his security people and be back in touch. [redacted] of Security has already indicated the areas of concern to the OSD security man, [redacted] K1
