office of Representative John E. Pillion, regarding an inquiry the Congress-  
man had received from a Veteran's organization containing an assumption  
that two organizations, The Federation of the America's and Operations  
of Organisation Internationale de Protection Civile, were Communist. I  
advised Rourke that the latter organization was one of which the United States  
was a member and was in effect a Civil Defense organization and that the  
Federation of Americas' had been in existence, although dormant, for 25X1  
about thirteen years, adding that it has recently made extensive mailings to  
addresses in the U. S. [redacted]
