Pro-Cuban Continental Congress To Be Held in Rio de Janeiro in March

Available Brazilian papers up to 6 March 1963 had not carried the "Leite" and "Juliao" list of sponsors of the Continental Congress of Soladarity with Cuba as reported in <u>The Washington Post</u> on 11 March 1963. However, Rio de Janeiro <u>Correio da Manha</u> of 3 March 1963 said that the Brazilian National Security Council and the Secret Services of the Armed Forces were carefully studying the four documents taken from Communist leader Carlos Prestes as he left for Havana via Prague. Despite their secret nature, <u>Correio da Manha</u> declared, its reported had examined the documents.

FDD has followed the build-up for this congress since the time Peasant League leader Francisco Juliao read a manifesto calling for the meeting, which was reported in the pro-Communist Rio paper <u>O Semanario</u> in late September 1962.

Venezuelan Communist Party Document on Continued Guerrilla Warfare

The Washington Star of 10 March 1963 reported that the Venezuelan Government had published a document, which it called the Communists' blueprint for seizing power in Venezuela.

Venezuelan newspapers through 3 March 1963, the only ones available to FDD at this time, indicate that such a document was released to the public by Acting Minister of the Interior Alejandro Oropeza Castillo on 25 ebruary 1963, according to a report in the Caracas daily <u>El ^Nacional</u> of that date.
