5. [redacted] OSI,  
called to discuss the possibility of making contact with a group of  
Congressmen, headed by Representative Roman Pucinski, who will  
be travelling to Moscow to study Soviet progress in the field of automatic  
data processing. OSI would like to brief this group and make some  
suggestions which might be helpful to OSI. Other members of the delegation  
are Representatives Hugh L. Carey, John Brademas, Paul Findley, and  
Alphonse Bell. (I mentioned to Marshall that Representative Brademas  
would be visiting the Agency on 4 June along with a group of other  
Congressmen and it might be feasible to discuss this with him at that  
time.) I advised we would give this matter some thought and be back  
in touch with him.
