8. (Internal Use Only - JGO) Mr. Sam Archibald, Staff Director of the Moss Information Subcommittee, advised that Mr. Moss did not believe that an informal meeting between himself, Archibald, and myself at this time would be worthwhile. He does not feel that he should bargain away the right of the Committee to publish hearings with the Agency but rather that the Agency could certainly as in the past be their own judge of what information is classified or inappropriate for release and so correct any transcript. I thanked Mr. Archibald for the information and told him I would be back in touch. No time press is apparent as to a date for a meeting with the Committee.

9. (Unclassified - JGO) I provided Mr. Walter Mote, Professional Staff Member of the Senate Rules Committee, with the names and telephone extensions of [redacted] for an interview for his brother Max Mote later in the week when he arrives back from Princeton.
