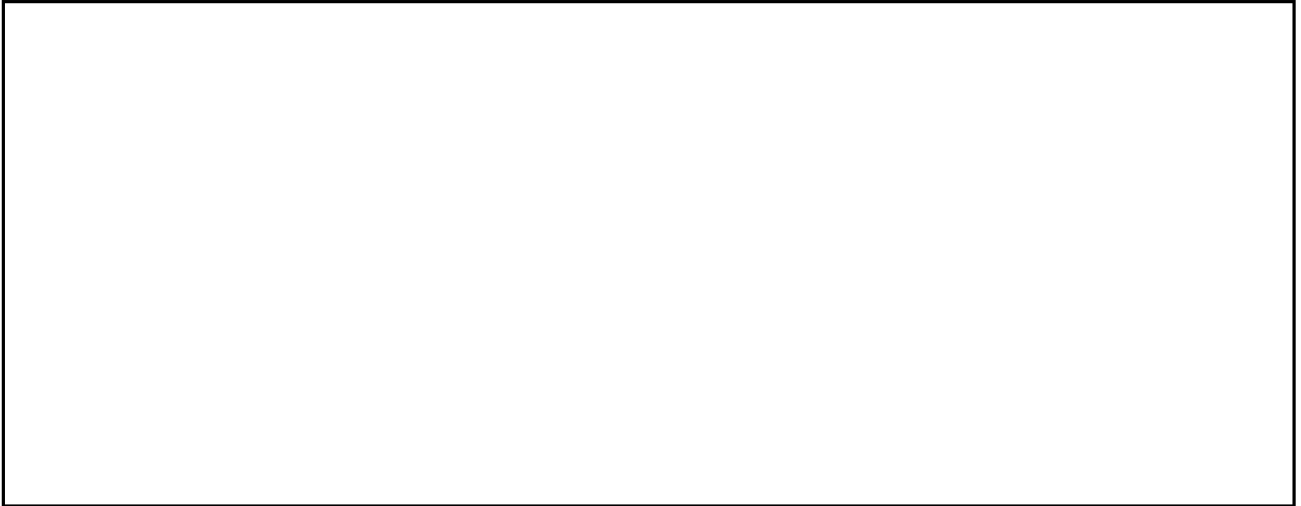

6. [redacted] George Murphy, Joint Committee on Atomic Energy staff, called and said a member of the Joint Committee had asked the staff for open references by the Cubans to the establishment of a missile tracking station in Cuba. Murphy said they would like any citations to such statements and might also like to know what the Agency knows about this station. After checking with [redacted] OSI, I gave Murphy references to a Moscow International broadcast of 3 February and a Havana broadcast of 6 April 1964 on this subject which were monitored and translated by FBIS.

[redacted] USIA had discussed with him a request they had received from the House Committee on Un-American Activities, requesting a list of political warfare schools. [redacted] 25X1
requested any advice we could give USIA on this. I gave [redacted] the history of this situation including the inquiry we received from Representative Pillion and our conversations with the State Department who had received a similar inquiry from HCUA. I suggested that USIA get in touch with the Department to discuss the matter of an appropriate reply.

25X1 9. [redacted] Received another call from George Murphy, ICAE, regarding an Agency employee, [redacted] who 25X1
has applied for and is being seriously considered for a position on the ICAE staff. Murphy asked if "in keeping with new security policies the Agency would send the Committee [redacted] security file so that 25X1
the Joint Committee would have some basis for making a determination as to whether [redacted] would be given a ICAE clearance. After some 25X1
discussion of these procedures including Murphy's description of their normal arrangements with the FBI in requesting a field investigation of a prospective employee, Murphy recast his request asking for the "investigative file" [redacted] I told Murphy I would look into the 25X1
