

[] Miss Patricia McMahon, Senate Foreign Relations Committee Staff, called and asked if the Agency could submit a report to the Committee by Friday on Senate Resolution 204, a bill introduced by Senator Ribicoff and having many co-sponsors, which would express the sense of the Senate in condemning the Soviet Union for the persecution of Jews. (The Bureau of the Budget has not cleared any reports on this bill, but State Department and several others have reports pending. We have requested copies of these in order to firm up an Agency position on the Resolution.)



25X1 7. [] Former Congressman James VanZandt called and asked if the Agency would make appropriate arrangements to contact [] Pennsylvania. [] 25X1 has expressed an interest in working overseas with the government, particularly with the Agency. Mr. VanZandt said this interest had been expressed to the Governor who had in turn contacted Mr. VanZandt. I advised VanZandt that we would make arrangements for an appropriate contact with [] and he could notify him to this effect without specifically giving the Agency's name. 25X1
