6. (Unclassified - JSW) Mr. Warner and [redacted] sat in on the meeting of the House Armed Services Committee where the Senate amendments to the early retirement bill were discussed. The Committee unanimously agreed to accept the Senate amendments. Mr. Hardy expressed concern that the Senate had cut out too much in the bill but under Mr. Vinson's urging did not object.
