SUBJECT : Hotel Accommodations in New York During the
1964 World's Fair

1. Colonel White has asked that consideration be given to hotel accommodations which will be required by Agency personnel who must travel to New York on official business during the 1964 World's Fair. It seems likely that transient quarters will be difficult to obtain and that we may need to lease some space in order that personnel spending more than one day in New York during the Fair will not have to commute daily.
