Intelligence Committee for the Foreign Information Program and Planning for Overt Psychological Warfare

 The National Security Council is currently considering and probably will approve the Report to the National Security Council, NSC 59, dated 20 December 1949, providing for the conduct of the national foreign information program in time of peace and the planning for overt psychological warfare. MSC 59 provides for the establishment within the Department of State of an interdepartmental organization consisting of a director, policy consultants, a CIA consultant for matters relating to planning under the MSC 10 series, and an interdepartmental staff. On the staff, this Agency is represented by a full time member whose responsibilities are to act as a foreign intelligence adviser to the interdepartmental organization.

- 2. In order to mobilize the foreign intelligence effort of the government for the purpose of more effectively supporting the national foreign information program and planning for overt psychological warfare, I should like to activate an intelligence committee to serve under the chairmanship of this Agency's representative on that interdepartmental staff.
- 3. Will you, therefore, at your earliest convenience, designate a member of your organization to serve on this intelligence committee? The place and time of meetings, together with its substantive work, will be determined by the committee in the light of demands made upon it.
