1. Reference is made to a recent item on the Union of the Free Press in Germany in a Polish-American newspaper, Zwiazek Wolnej Prasy Whiemczech. The article stated that there are nineteen DP newspapers in Germany which are partially subsidized by the IRO whose headquarters are in Bad Kissinjen. The Union, whose headquarters is in Augsburg, was formed by the editors and publishers of the nineteen newspapers. On 3 September 1950 the following persons were elected to the presidium of the Union:

- a. Stanislaw Moscinski, Polish - President
- b. Dr. Makre, Hungarian - Secretary
- c. Editor Pedak, Estonian - Treasurer
