Sensitive Intelligence

Sensitive intelligence is defined as that intelligence, the unauthorized disclosure of which could (1) jeopardize the continued productivity of an intelligence source or method which is providing intelligence vital to the national security of the U.S., or (2) lead to counteraction negating the value of intelligence vital to the national security of U.S.
