The services and equipment being procured by this Contract No. **SH-516** **AF 33(657)-13272** are in furtherance of the **WARNING** Program(s), the nature of which cannot be publicly disclosed for security reasons. The Contracting Officer therefore determines that this procurement must be accomplished by negotiations pursuant to the authority of Section 3(a) of PL 81-110 and Class Determination and Finding, OXC 2122, signed by the DDCI on 15 October 1961.

Certification of funds for this contract will be handled under the procedure approved by the Director of Central Intelligence on 15 December 1956 which, in effect, results in all covert expenses involving issuance of Treasury Checks being accumulated in a separate account within the Finance Division. The amounts in this account will be periodically scheduled for certification of the vouchers by the Director. This procedure eliminates the necessity for a separate certification of authority under Section 8(b) of Public Law 110, 81st Congress (formerly 10(b) - see 85-507 dated 7/7/58) for each contract.

The following comments describe the procurement hereby effected, the terms and provisions generally of this contract/amendment, and a resume of major issues negotiated:

Contract No. SH-516 has been written with the Shell Oil Company to cover the installation of Fuel Facilities at Edwards AFB, California and the modification of four (4) fuel trailers for Project OXCART.

The price of \$178,500 for Facilities is subject to price redetermination. No profit is contemplated; however, of this amount \$8,500 representing overhead, supervising costs, travel, engineering costs and materials handling is not subject to adjustment. The price for the trailer modification, \$4,726.00 is also not subject to redetermination.

The above prices have been reviewed by the negotiator and are considered fair and reasonable.

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
