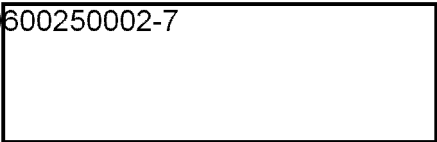

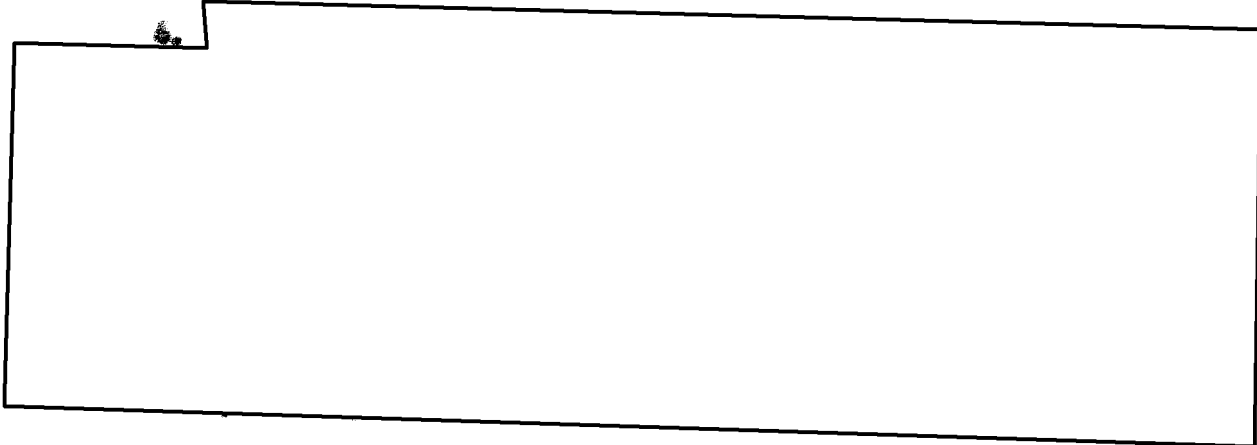

5. [redacted] Mr. Rex Beach, in the office of Senator James B. Pearson, called and asked if we had a map of South Vietnam showing those areas which are occupied by the Vietcong. After checking with GEA/Cartography Division and [redacted] of the DE/I office, Mr. Beach was advised that the only maps which the Agency had on this were classified, however, we suggested that he contact Mr. Arthur Sylvester's office in the Pentagon since any maps on this subject were based on military intelligence. I told Mr. Beach that if he should have any great difficulty on this to give me another call.
