E. THE FILM ARRIVED IN GOOD PHYSICAL CONDITION WITH NORMAL EXPOSURE WITH EXCEPTION OF UNDEREXPOSURE IN FIRST PART OF THE MISSION AND AGAIN APPROXIMATELY 60 PER CENT INTO THE MISSION OVER 80 FRAMES. THESE FRAMES WERE THE EQUIVALENT OF 2 F/STOPS UNDEREXPOSED. MEDIUM CONTRAST, GOOD RESOLUTION AND OPERATIONAL DATA RECORDING WERE NOTED. APPROXIMATELY ONE HALF OF ALL FORWARD CLOCKS IN IMAGE AREA THROUGHOUT ENTIRE MISSION. EDGES BETWEEN FORWARD AND AFT FRAMES WERE FUZZY. TIMING MARKS APPEARED AS TEARS AND DASHES INTERMITTENTLY THROUGHOUT MISSION. START UP AND SHUTDOWN WERE NORMAL WITH INITIAL SIX FRAMES AND LAST TEN FRAMES OVERLAPED. CAMERA RECYCLED APPROXIMATELY 55 PER CENT INTO MISSION.
