25X1 6. [redacted] Met with Russ Blandford, House Armed Services Committee staff, and went into a detailed review of S. 1035 as it now stands so that he could appropriately brief Chairman Rivers. His view was very strong that this was a poor bill for Government as a whole let alone the sensitive agencies. He said he would discuss with the Chairman what appropriate steps could be taken at this stage.

25X1 7. [redacted] In connection with a call from Mr. Paul Demos, Administrative Assistant to Senator Joseph M. Montoya (D., N.Mex.), to [redacted] I learned that [redacted] had been suggested as a source of information for a keynote address to be made by Senator Montoya on 1 November at a symposium sponsored by Missile Electronic Warfare Technical Area and "Old Crows" at White Sands, New Mexico. [redacted] will pursue an alternate way of providing information for the speech to Senator Montoya through the White Sands installation and will advise us if any difficulties develop.
