Making It Easy

The ink had hardly dried on a warning by Allen W. Dulles, director of the highly-secret Central Intelligence Agency, that "We tell Russia too much" when the Defense Department bared a virtual catalog of new and old American weapons.

Identified as a production record, the Defense Department directive became available to reporters in a daily batch of run of the mine departmental orders. It gave production details on our newest guided missiles and on the Army's bombardment rocket, "Honest John," among others. It bore no secrecy label.
