

## SOFT THINKER CALLED DANGER TO SECURITY

WASHINGTON, Jan. 29 (UP)—  
Allen W. Dulles, Director of  
Central Intelligence, said today  
that neutrals and "soft thinkers"  
were a greater danger than  
avowed Communists.

He said Soviet Russia spent  
about \$2,000,000,000 a year on  
"front" organizations and allied  
activities that concealed the real  
purpose of the Communist con-  
spiracy.

"They should not be allowed to  
get away with this hoax and de-  
ception any longer," he said.

Addressing a women's forum  
on national security, Mr. Dulles  
stressed the amount of time and  
money the Russians were willing  
to put into "front" organiza-  
tions as "a softening process" to  
prepare for the day they could  
take over.

"Today it is not the open Com-  
munist, the admitted follower of  
Marx and Lenin, who is likely to  
trip us up," he said. "It is the  
neutralist, the soft thinkers  
about agrarian reforms, those  
who merely decry the methods  
but are blind to the aim of in-  
ternational communism."

He said the danger was greater  
in other parts of the world than  
it was in the United States,  
where, he added, communism "is  
no longer coddled or tolerated"
