

### Murphy States Talks On West German Tour

Deputy Undersecretary of State Robert Murphy will leave Sunday for a visit to West Germany which includes speeches in West Berlin and talks with German leaders at Bonn.

The State Department said the main purpose of his trip will be to represent the United States at ceremonies in Berlin at the laying of the cornerstone of a new conference hall. Mrs. Eleanor Dulles, sister of Secretary of State Dulles, and Representative Keating, Republican of New York, will accompany him. Mrs. Dulles is a special assistant to the director of the department's Office of German Affairs.
