CPYRGHT Reds Subvert Free Nations

Kremlin leaders have devised an insidious new strategy of "parliamentary conquest" of free nations—and principal targets are now Italy, France, and Indonesia, says Allen W. Dulles, director of the United States central intelligence agency.

The communists' latest method of trying to enslave democratic nations was devised after the surprising de-Stalinization program earlier this year.

Noting that right wing parties in many countries are suffering bankruptcy with increasing frequency, the communists are trying to infiltrate the legislative systems of free governments, using the freedoms which democracies have established to destroy all vestiges of that system.

That is the Moscow blueprint, the

CIA director warned in a Labor day-weekend statement to the house committee on un-American activities. Nikita Khrushchev, Premier Bulganin, and other Russian leaders, Dulles said, are convinced that fresh opportunities exist in Italy, France, Indonesia, and other free nations.

U.S. foreign policy should be tailored to counteract these communist coups. The reds obtain an effective minority position in a government through the democratic process of a popular vote; then the reds persuade leftist parties to join in political alliances, and sometimes even get communists admitted to key government positions. The final step is communist manipulation of key ministries to drive the anti-communists out of positions of influence.
