4... Although Congressional bills introduced to revise Congressional watchdog procedures, Senators Dirksen and Mansfield and Rep Ford stated to Press Feb. 24 there was no need for special investigation of CIA.

5. Survey of posts' response to Tel 140124 indicates that criticism abroad so far as result QTE revelations UNQTE generally moderate. Covert manner of alleged funding is chief focus of criticism - rather than fact of govt support (which many govts extend, as demonstrated in CA-6361, en route all posts). Disillusionment, disappointment, cynicism, some moralizing characterize many reactions, but sympathetic understanding Cold War problems also expressed. Most posts believe U.S. programs and voluntary agencies will not be greatly affected. However there are some individual exceptions to this statement, and more may appear. Full reaction many posts delayed because of slow communication and overshadowing by local problems, and further developments if reported abroad, especially if local groups or prominent citizens involved, could intensify reactions. Continued reporting of significant reactions or opinion trends will be appreciated.
