Mr. MAGNUSON (by request) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Government Operations

A BILL

To amend the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 to provide that the procurement of certain transportation and public utility services shall be in accordance with all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations governing carriers and public utilities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 201 of the Federal Property and Administra-
4 tive Services Act of 1949 (63 Stat. 377, as amended; 40
5 U.S.C. 481) is amended by adding at the end thereof the
6 following new subsection:

7 “(e) Any other provision of this Act or any other Act

8 to the contrary notwithstanding, the procurement of trans-

1 portation and public utility services under the provisions of
2 this Act or any other Act shall be in accordance with all
3 applicable Federal and State laws and regulations govern-
4 ing carriers and public utilities: *Provided*, That the Secre-
5 tary of Defense may from time to time, and unless the Presi-
6 dent shall otherwise direct, exempt the Department of De-
7 fense from action taken or which may be taken by the Ad-
8 ministrator under clauses (1)-(4) of subsection (a) of
9 this section whenever he determines exemption from such
10 action to be in the best interests of national security."
