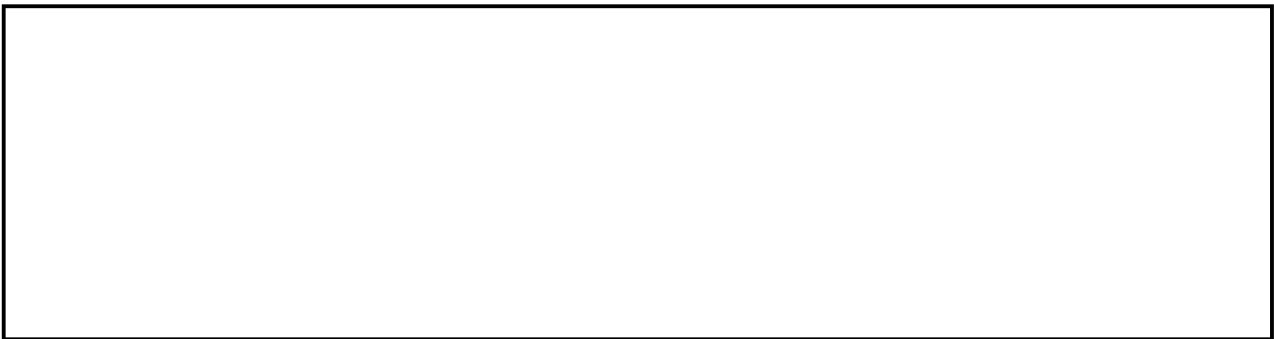

(Unclassified - LLM) Called Miss Josephine Scheiber, staff member of the Conservation and Natural Resources Subcommittee, House Government Operations Committee, in connection with the Subcommittee's request for a report on air pollution at Agency installations. Miss Scheiber agreed that since GSA would be furnishing the Subcommittee this information a duplicate report from us would serve no useful purpose, and she asked that we write a short note along these lines to Chairman Reuss.
