7. [REDACTED] Mrs. Shaffer, in the office of Representative G. William Whitehurst (R., Va.), called on behalf of a constituent who, in connection with his desire to fight in Indochina as a mercenary, wanted to know where he could file his application and the effect this might have on his citizenship. I referred her to the Department of State on the citizenship question and explained that the inquiry probably had been prompted by a news item which was erroneous as far as we were concerned. She seemed satisfied but commented that she knew of some unusual recruiting among the OCS class now at Quantico.
