## Chile Paper Says U.S. Institute Is Spy Center

HAVANA — The American Institute for the Development of Free Trade Unions, situated in Washington, is a U.S. spy-training center, the Chilean newspaper "Ultima Hora" writes.

The newspaper says that the institute has agents in 17 Latin American countries who more than once have had their hand in coups which have overthrown lawful governments.

According to a Prensa Latina report from Santiago, this school of subversion has trained 7,500 men for subversive activities in Latin America since 1962. At present the U.S. Government has appropriated to the institute \$10 million for subversion.
