

### Salinger Gets New Film Post

NEW YORK (AP)—Pierre Salinger, former White House news secretary, has been named president of a corporation which will investigate worldwide motion picture operations and prospects, it was announced Wednesday.

He will head the Fox Overseas Corp., which has been formed by the National General Corp. and Continental Air Services, Inc. Salinger already holds positions with both parent corporations.

Salinger was news secretary under Presidents Lyndon B. Johnson and John F. Kennedy. He later was appointed Senator from California, but was defeated for election.

The new appointment will be effective Sept. 15.

The announcement said it is expected that Salinger will travel widely in Europe, Asia and Africa.

In addition, Salinger will devote time to operations of Continental Air Services in Southeast Asia and Continental Air Lines international operations.
