BOB AMORY, DDI -- HAMBON BALDWIN. JOHN STEELE

SJG told Amory that Steele had called him to say that LIFE has the Harrison story of the conversation which it will run in its next issue and that Steels is now asking to talk to Bob Amory or the Director to get an eff-the-record discussion of the meaning of this. Amory commented that that was very interesting because the Bess had just told him that C.D. Jackson knew nothing about the Harrisman version of the story.

The conversation shifted to Amery's recent appointment with Hanson Haldwin: Amory said he had written a memorandum for the Record about it for the Director at his request. He said to be perfectly frank about it, he did not turn in a report to SJG on the contact because the last time Baldwin was here he took exception to Col. Grogan's being present and asked if the next time he saw him he might not have lunch with him. Amory said he probably should not have agreed but since he had had lunch with Baldvin before he did agree.

DCI -- PALEY, STEELE

SJC called the Director and teld him that Ted Keop had asked him to call the Director and to tell him from Joe Ream that Bill Paley is now in Europe but -should anything develop re their conversation, Faley would be glad to return immediately from Europe. The Director commented that he had not done much about this as yet.

SJG said Steels had called him again to say they now have received from Harriman, his own story. New York has asked that Steele see the Director or Bob Amory and get an eff-the-record discussion of the significance. The Director expressed belief that we could not do this and that they ought to go to the State Department. SJG said be would refer Steele there. The DCI said he just talked to C. D. Jackson who said they are not going to run the story entil the issue fellowing this one of LIFE. (SJG's understanding had been that it would herin the issue coming out this week.)

330 said he would call Amery and tell him to refer all calls received on this subject to the State Bepartment.

SUG called Amery and told him of his call with the Director and usked him to refer all calls to State. Amony said he would do this.
