MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR:

This memorandum is for information only.

Mr. Amory told me that you would like to get in touch with Hanson Baldwin as soon as possible after his return from overseas. He is in Cairo and it was at first believed that he would remain there another month. However, his assistant, Ed Mossine, told me that Baldwin is now expected in New York next Thursday, 20 December, being particularly anxious to get home for the holidays.
