25X1 9. [redacted] Left with Miss Lynn Feeney, on the staff of Representative Lawrence J. Hogan (R., Md.), a copy of the China Atlas which she had requested.

25X1 10. [redacted] Mr. Conrad Philos, Chief, Legislative Relief, U.S. Army, called to learn our views on the enrolled bill for [redacted] and concluded that their views to the Office of Management and Budget on this subject would defer to our position.
