

'Ervin-type Bills'

92nd Congress

A. S. 1438: Ervin (D., N. C.)

Identical to the "Ervin bill" which was approved by the Senate in the 91st Congress (S. 782). Grants complete exemption for FBI and partial exemption for CIA and NSA.

Companion Bill:

H. R. 7969: Galifianakis (D., N. C.)

B. H. R. 7199: Wilson (D., Calif.)

Active before Employee Benefits Subcommittee of House Post Office and Civil Service. Substantially similar to Ervin bill (S. 1438) with following exceptions:

- (a). grants partial, not full, exemption for FBI;
- (b). does not require CIA and NSA employees to wait 120 days for an internal decision before a complaint can be filed externally.
