1.				<p>The attached <u>Congressional Record</u> excerpt covers Senate approval of the Dominick amendment to a provision in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1972 which would have affected the use of third country nationals in military operations in Laos, Thailand, or North Vietnam and which was principally aimed at the Thai irregulars.</p> <p>As a result Laos and North Vietnam were deleted from the provision along with requirements that Congress designate areas for approved military operations and obtain exact details prior to the operations.</p> <p>Passages marked for your information also include Fulbright/Symington colloquy (on money problems, executive evasion of existing legal restraints, and doubts that Laos is important to U.S. or that Thai irregulars are important to Laos) and supporting statements by Senators Stennis and Young.</p> <div style="background-color: black; width: 150px; height: 40px; margin: 10px auto;"></div> <p style="text-align: right;">Assistant Legislative Counsel</p> <p>cc: DCI, DDCI, Ex/Dir, DDI, DDP, DDS&amp;T, DDS, OGC, IC, SAVA, OPPB, C/FE, <span style="background-color: black; color: black;">XXXXXXXXXX</span></p>
