REASSIGNMENT FROM CIA becomes automatic for Army LGen Marshall S. "Pat" Carter, 55, USMA '31, Deputy Director, with President's designation of VAdm William F. "Red" Raborn, USN-Ret., as Director. Law prohibits military men from holding 2 top posts.

ADMIRAL RABORN will receive \$30,000 as CIA Director—same pay as Deputy Defense Secretary, and Secretaries of Army, Navy and AF. In addition, he will receive first \$2000 plus half of the remainder of his retired pay—a total of approximately \$8000. New CIA Director could receive full civilian salary and full retired pay if Civil Service Commission certifies that his employment meets "special or emergency" needs which "otherwise cannot readily be met."
