NEW YORK (AP)—The man responsible for negotiating the return of 1,163 Cubans captured in the Bay of Pigs invasion and who helped free U-2 pilot Francis Gary Powers from a Russian jail will become president of Pratt Institute.

He is James B. Donovan, 51, a former president of the city board of education. He was named to the post at the 80th Founder's Day convocation at the college yesterday. He will start his new job Jan. 1.

Donovan, a Democrat who lost a bid for a U.S. Senate seat to incumbent Jacob K. Javits in 1962, served as guest lecturer at a number of colleges and universities.
