Many Attend Golden Wedding Fete for the Jules Borels

Paul Borel, assistant director of the Central Intelligence agency, with his brothers and sister and their children, attended a dinner Saturday night honoring Mr. and Mrs. Jules Borel, 4090 West Sixty-second street, Terrace Mission, on their golden wedding anniversary.

The older Borels were married in Zurich, Switzerland, and came to Kansas City in 1917. He and three of his sons now operate Jules Borel & Co., 1110 Grand avenue.

The four brothers, a sister, and their children, totaling 33 persons, attended the golden wedding dinner Friday night at the home of Pierre Borel, 4200 West Fifty-seventh street, Prairie Village.

Paul Borel and his family arrived Wednesday from Washington and will return Wednesday. He is a top aide to Allen W. Dulles, director of the CIA, who, as a secretary of the American legation in Switzerland, signed the family's passports to immigrate to the United States.
