Hertz, 48, born in Brooklyn in Brooklyn, was seized by the Viet Cong while on a motorbike ride near the capital. He was chief

public administrations adviser to the U.S ai.d mission here. Through intermediaries, the U.S. offered Red terrorist Nguyen Van Hai, 34, in exchange for Hertz.

Last April, the Communists threatened to kill Hertz if Hai, to blow up the U.S. embassy here March 30, was executed. Behind-the-scenes efforts by U.S. officials here managed to stave off the execution.
